Bachelor's of Choice + Teaching License

Students who are in WCAS, School of Comm, or another NU school besides SESP can earn teacher licensure while staying in their home school!

Bachelor's of Science in Education in Teaching

Students in SESP can obtain their Bachelor of Science in Education with a concentration in Teaching.

Accelerated Master of Science in Education in Teaching

The Accelerated program allows Northwestern undergrads to take courses toward the MS in Education & Social Policy degree, which is normally 15 units. With a little planning, Northwestern undergrads can reduce the length of the program to as few as 9 units.

Traditional Master of Science in Education in Teaching

Complete a master's degree following graduation.



All teaching candidates will choose between **Elementary Teaching (grades 1-6, general classroom teacher)** or **Secondary Teaching (grades 5-12, content area teacher)**. Options are: **English, Math, Science, or Social Science**. Spanish is also available for grades PK-12.)
