#### **Bachelor's of Choice + Teaching License**

Students who are in WCAS, School of Comm, or another NU school besides SESP can earn teacher licensure while staying in their home school!

#### **Bachelor's of Science in Education in Teaching**

Students in SESP can obtain their Bachelor of Science in Education with a concentration in Teaching.

Accelerated Master of Science in Education in Teaching

The Accelerated program allows Northwestern undergrads to take courses toward the MS in Education & Social Policy degree, which is normally 15 units. With a little planning, Northwestern undergrads can reduce the length of the program to as few as 9 units.

### Traditional Master of Science in Education in Teaching

Complete a master's degree following graduation.

All teaching candidates will choose between Elementary Teaching (grades 1-6, general classroom teacher) or Secondary Teaching (grades 5-12, content area teacher. Options are: English, Math, Science, or Social Science. Spanish is also available for grades PK-12.)
